





FENS Summer School on "Scientific basis for FBDGs – new challenges"

August 19th to 23th, 2019

The FENS summer school is addressing young scientists (students (master/doctoral) and post-docs) preferentially with an epidemiological or public health background that would like to get up to date knowledge how to translate scientific findings into recommendations, particularly food based dietary guidelines.

In this summer school, you will meet the leading experts from Europe in this field but also many local scientists from a very interesting region of Europe. The lectures are spanning around the conception and practical aspects of Food based dietary guidelines (FBDGs) and also include some broader topics of use and translation of scientific data for public health initiatives.

The FENS summer school intends to support professional and personal capacity building by providing a stimulating atmosphere for one week that could be used to update the knowledge, to learn about perspectives of scientific approaches, and to build up own networks with nice people.


